/// BACKGROUND

For many decades now, institutions across the world are making several measures to address the challenges of sustainable development and social well being through education, research and outreach. These measures have gained further international prominence as can be seen in the recently concluded Rio+20 and "World Symposium on Sustainable Development at Universities" (WSSD-U-2012) held in Rio, Brazil. It is more evident that a green campus revolution is unfolding in every corner of the world.

Today, more than ever before, institutions have the policy climate, community support and technology innovation to remain at the leading edge of this revolution. It is against this background that the "Green Campus Summit" (GCS-2013) will be organised at Puducherry by the Association for Promoting Sustainability in Campuses and Communities (APSCC). The event is organised under the auspices of the Research and Transfer Centre, Applications of Life Sciences of the Hamburg University of Applied Sciences (Germany) and Centre for International Business and Sustainability (CIBS), London Metropolitan University (UK) and Pondicherry University (India).

Whether setting aggressive goals towards energy/water/food security or rediscovering the value of biodiversity or enacting the region's first green building code, or launching a pioneering effort to integrate sustainability into the core activities of the institution, this summit will help set the pace to rediscover your organisation with a commitment to foster sustainable development. As the premier campus greening event, the summit will convene more than 300 faculty, staff, administrators, researcher's, and student's from various institutions in India and across the world. GCS-2013 provides a wonderful opportunity to build new relationships and connect with colleagues from around the world.

/// AIMS

The aims of the "Green Campus Summit" (GCS-2013) are as follows:

- i. to provide Universities and Higher Educational Institutions all round the world with an opportunity to display and present their works on campus greening (i.e. curriculum innovation, restructuring, action research, activities, practical projects, etc..);
- ii. to foster the exchange of information, and dissemination of knowledge, ideas and experiences acquired in the execution of projects, from successful initiatives and best practices:
- iii. to promote adopting/ implementing strategies for campus sustainability;
- iv. to provide opportunity to showcase thought leadership on campus sustainability for institutional/ industrial campuses all round the world;
- v. to discuss methodological approaches and projects which aim to integrate the topic of campus greening in Universities, Higher Educational Institutions and even other organisations:
- vi. to network the participants and provide a platform so they can explore possibilities for cooperation and collaboration.

A further aim of the event will be to document and disseminate the wealth of experiences available today. To this purpose, a book "Green Campus" with selected papers from the conference will be produced. This will be a further volume of the award-winning book series "Environmental Education, Communication and Sustainability" (Peter Lang Scientific Publishers), which since its creation in 1998 has become the world's longest running book series on education and communication on sustainable development.



/// PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

Delegates attending the "Green Campus Summit 2013" will come from a cross-sectoral range of areas such as:

It will be an historical initiative with a wide range of participants helping to outline the need for integrated approaches towards campus greening and, hence contribute to the further dissemination of the UN Decade of Education for Sustainable Development.

/// STRUCTURE OF THE EVENT

The "Green Campus Summit 2013" will be organised in two main strands:

Strand 1: Displays

Participating universities and organisations will be able to put-up displays describing their works and projects and to distribute the relevant information to the participants. The displays will be the backbone of the event and will allow close, one-to-one contacts between the participants and the exhibitors.

Strand 2: Presentations

A set of presentations, divided into three sections will be organised, dealing with the challenges of campus sustainability initiatives. These are:

Session 1: Research and Outreach Programmes for campus greening initiatives

Session 2: Integrating green initiatives with the core activities

Session 3: Models and case studies of campus sustainability programmes

The presentations will be complemented by a round-table with some key experts.

Recent research and case studies covering any aspect of campus sustainability will be accepted. Some of the topics include

- environmental education and curriculum development
- outreach programmes
- sustainable management of water resources (water harvesting, greywater reclamation and reuse, etc..)
- energy efficiency and green energy
- solid waste/ hazardous waste/ toxic waste management
- food services and food security
- biodiversity conservation and habitat restoration
- land use management
- green buildings
- · green purchasing
- sustainable transportation
- integration of technology for campus sustainability

Strand 3: Exhibits

A number of organisations will network and do business by showcasing the latest in innovative products and services that enables the campuses to increase their sustainability quotient.
